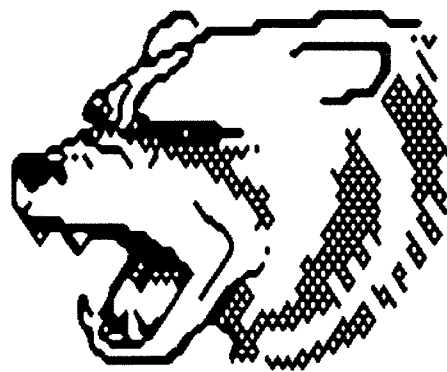

Spot ya at the red peg !!!

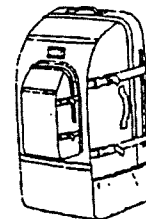

AMMENDMENT TO SHOOTING DIVISION

At a club meeting held on August 4, 1996, with 27 members and 4 visitors, the following remit was discussed:

REMIT: Submitted by Paddy Long, Sunday 8th July 1996.

That the Equipment specifications for the BOWHUNTER LIMITED division be upgraded as follows:

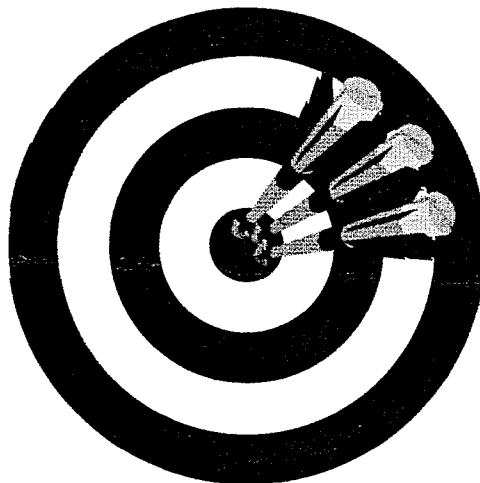
BOWHUNTER LIMITED:

Any bow, maximum 5 fixed sight points, peep sight or kisser, but not both. No clickers allowed. Arrows must have minimum 125 grain field point. Maximum 12" stabiliser. Finger release only.

REASON:

A growing number of our members are shooting with 5 pins and peep but with finger release, and it is unfair on them to have them shooting against release aid shooters in the Bowhunter Freestyle division. There is also a dwindling number of 3 pin/no peep shooter in the Bowhunter Limited division. Upgrading the specifications for Bowhunter Limited as outlined above would more fairly reflect the current equipment trends, and also provide more even competition within the finger release sighted shooters division.

After discussion, the remit was put as a motion, moved by Paddy and seconded by Dave Bately. Passed unanimously. This to be effective as from Sunday 11th August 1996.

Okie "Lifetime" stabilisers have long been regarded as the finest bow stabiliser available anywhere. Their dual hydraulic stabilisers are designed to give you EXTRA control while maintaining moderate length and weight. Okie also manufacture a weight collar which slips over the outside of their "Lifetime" stabilisers. It has a shock resilient mount which allows the weight collar to absorb vibration and recoil while adding weight and changing the balance point of the bow to enhance the stabilisers efficiency.

We have the 1 x 11.5 inch, 16oz, the 1 x 8 inch, 14oz and the 1 x 5 inch, 9oz models in stock now as well as the Okie weight collar.

Easton have produced two new camo patterns to compliment their fine arrow range. The XX75 Advantage Camo is the first and come fitted with Easton's famous Super Uni bushing for perfect nock alignment. It comes in sizes from 2013 to 2514.

The second is the XX78 CamoExtreme Predator, also fitted with Easton's Super Uni bushing, it offers the durability and accuracy of the XX78. It come in sizes from 2213 to 2613. Yes, 2613 a great line cutting arrow for the field shooter as well as offering an extremely lightweight arrow for bowhunters using high poundage bows.

To go with these arrows you now have the choice of four colours of the Super Uni nock and the new 3-D Super nock. Black, White, Fluoro Green and Fluoro Orange. The new 3-D Super nock is especially designed for 3-D bows which are usually under 40 inches length and have acute string angles when at full draw. Often the nock set will dig into the nock of the arrow, the 3-D Super nock has indents on both sides of it eliminating any interference nock set may cause due to the acute string angle.

Golden Key is a name that has been associated with innovation for many years and the "Answer" release aid, a recent development, continues this trend. It comes with a comfortable wrist strap with velcro fastenings but its special feature is that it cannot be punched. This controls target panic or improper trigger control. The "Answer" guarantees a perfectly squeezed shot or it won't release (this feature can be quickly deactivated for hunting).

Do you want to increase the speed of your bow? "Neet Speed Masters", are 6 rubber buttons easily installed on your bowstring and can give you an increase in bow speed of up to 4-8 feet per second (+ or - variations can be expected).

For the Bowhunter we have Scorpion Spider Legs in Camo and Black. These string silencers are made of rubber, they are waterproof and hook grass proof.

Also with the Bowhunter in mind we now stock the Bohning Broadhead Sharpener. A light weight and compact sharpener it creates a razor sharp edge quickly and easily. A must for a Bowhunters field kit.

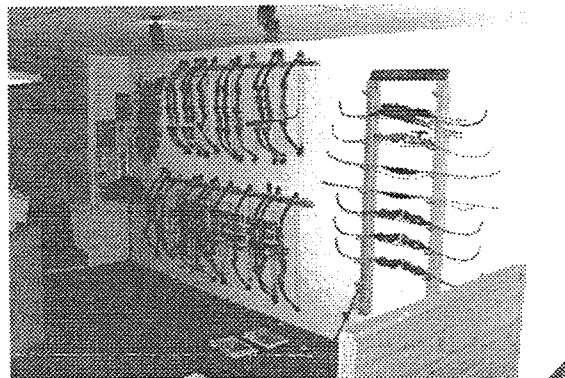
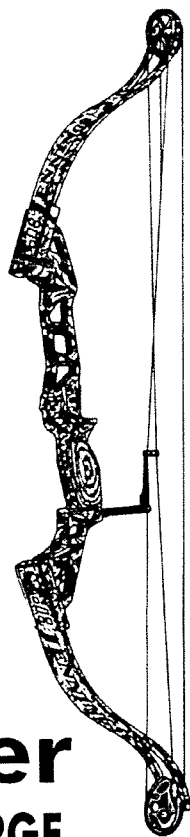
